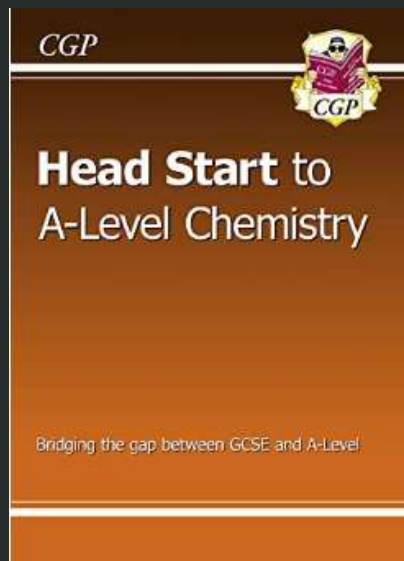


## Head start A-Level Chemistry
